

President of Timor Leste Arrives in Cambodia

Phnom Penh, March 29, 2011 AKP –

President of the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste, H.E. Dr. José Ramos-Horta, arrived here this morning for a three-day state visit to Cambodia from Mar. 29 to 31 at the invitation of Cambodian Prime Minister Samdech Akka Moha Sena Padei Techo Hun Sen.
